NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO DEREGISTER LAND REGISTERED AS COMMON LAND

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Mr Mark Penhaligan and Mrs Ansa Khan to Cambridgeshire County Council as the Commons Registration Authority under Schedule 2, paragraph 7 of the Commons Act 2006 concerning a parcel of land (shown coloured red on the accompanying map) at Burrough Green, which forms part of Burrough Green Village Green, directly in front of White Hart Farm, Bradley Rd, Burrough Green CB8 9NG.

Summary of the application:

The parcel of land concerned was incorrectly included in the registration of land under Section 4 of the 1965 Act and was not at this time common land.

If the application is granted the Registration Authority will remove the parcel of land from Burrough Green Village Green as detailed in the register of common land.

- State the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in the land affected by the application,
- Must be signed by the person making them
- Must state the grounds on which they are made

Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment, and may be disclosed to other interested parties. If the application is referred to the Planning Inspectorate for determination any representations will be sent to the Planning Inspectorate.
